Parkside veterinary group offers specialised orthopaedic diagnosis and repair. One of our Partners, Stuart Ashworth, has a further qualification in orthopaedics which allows us to give your pets the best care after fractures, ligament damage, spinal damage/disease and complex lamenesses. Other local Vets refer difficult cases to us for diagnosis and treatment. We carry out many bone repairs using pins, bone plates and external fixators. Stuart also performs the complicated Slocum method for repairing rupture to the anterior cruciate ligament, mostly done in larger dog breeds. This knee injury is often seen in footballers and needs surgical intervention in most cases to effect a good repair. The Slocum method of repair is only allowed after a course at the Slocum Foundation in America, which Stuart has attended and he is one of a handful of Vets in Scotland who can perform this operation.



It is reassuring to have new X-ray machines with dry processors for quick clear images in both Dundee and Barnhill surgeries. The diagnostic room also houses endoscopy (a tube for looking inside), ultrasound (for examining soft internal organs & pregnancies) and ECG facilities. The separate dental room (separate for increased hygiene) has an ultrasonic dental scaler (we have one in each surgery) for the best dental care and repair.



A prep area with separate operating theatres further increases cleanliness and new, top of the range vacuum sterilisers mean that we can provide the safest, cleanest operating environment for your pets.

We use the gaseous anaesthetic Isoflurane in all eight anaesthetic machines, for the safest maintenance of anaesthesia and quicker, hangover-free recovery for your pet. We give your pets the very best care, supported by our highly trained team of Veterinary Nurses, who monitor your pets constantly during and after anaesthesia, until they have fully recovered. Good teamwork from everyone.
